## The Youth Advisors' Drug Education Survey

We are researching drug education in London's secondary schools.

We want to find out how many schools are delivering drug education, how often and what it contains.

We decided on this research project after talking about our own experiences of drug education and finding really mixed results. Some of us had received good drug education, but others felt theirs had not been very useful at all.

We believe that all young people have a right to excellent drug education in their schools and we've created a short survey

to find out if this is true for young Londoners.

We need as many young Londoners to complete it as possible in order to get a clear picture .
